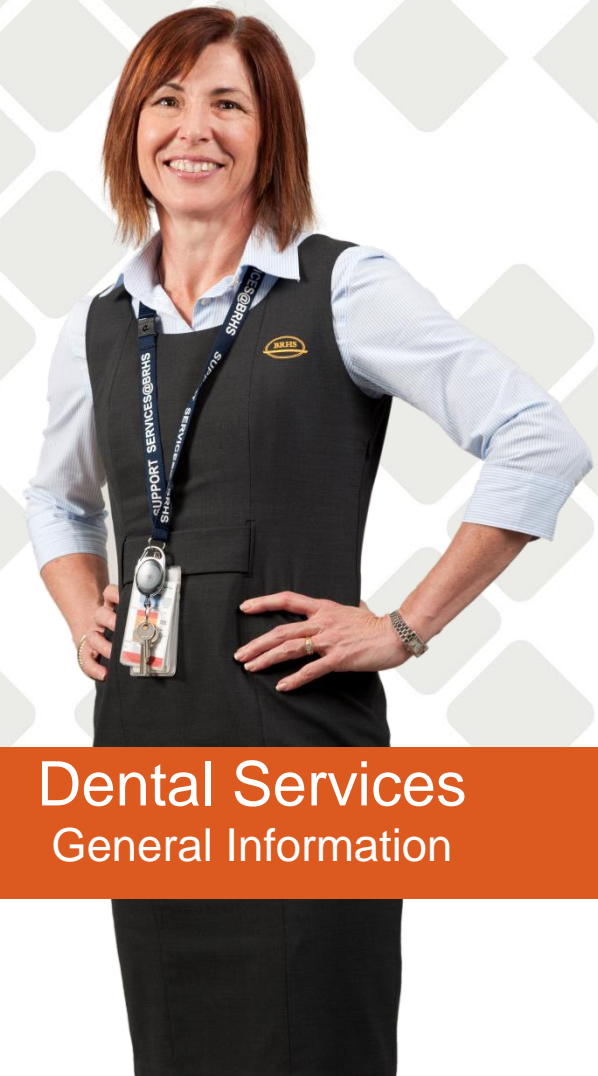

## ABOUT US

BRHS offers a variety of dental and oral health services to the community including:

- General Dental
- Emergency Dental
- Denture Services

## GENERAL DENTAL

- Check-ups and advice
- Cleaning
- Fillings
- Extractions

## EMERGENCY DENTAL

- Dental pain (e.g. in teeth, mouth, gum or jaw)
- Facial swelling
- Bleeding (trauma affecting your mouth)
- An accident involving your mouth or teeth

## DENTURE SERVICES

- Adjustments
- Repairs
- New dentures

## WHO CAN USE THE SERVICE?

- All children (12 years and under)
- Youth (13 to 17 years) who
  - ❖ hold a valid concession card,
  - ❖ are a dependant of a concession card holder,
  - ❖ are eligible for a Child Dental Benefits Scheme voucher, receive Family Tax Benefit A
  - ❖ receive out-of-home care provided by the Children Youth and Families Division of DHS
  - ❖ are a youth justice client in custodial care
- Refugees or asylum seekers
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people
- Registered clients of mental health and disability services, supported by a letter of recommendation from their case manager or staff of special development schools services
- All dependents of, or holders of, health care or pensioner concession cards.
